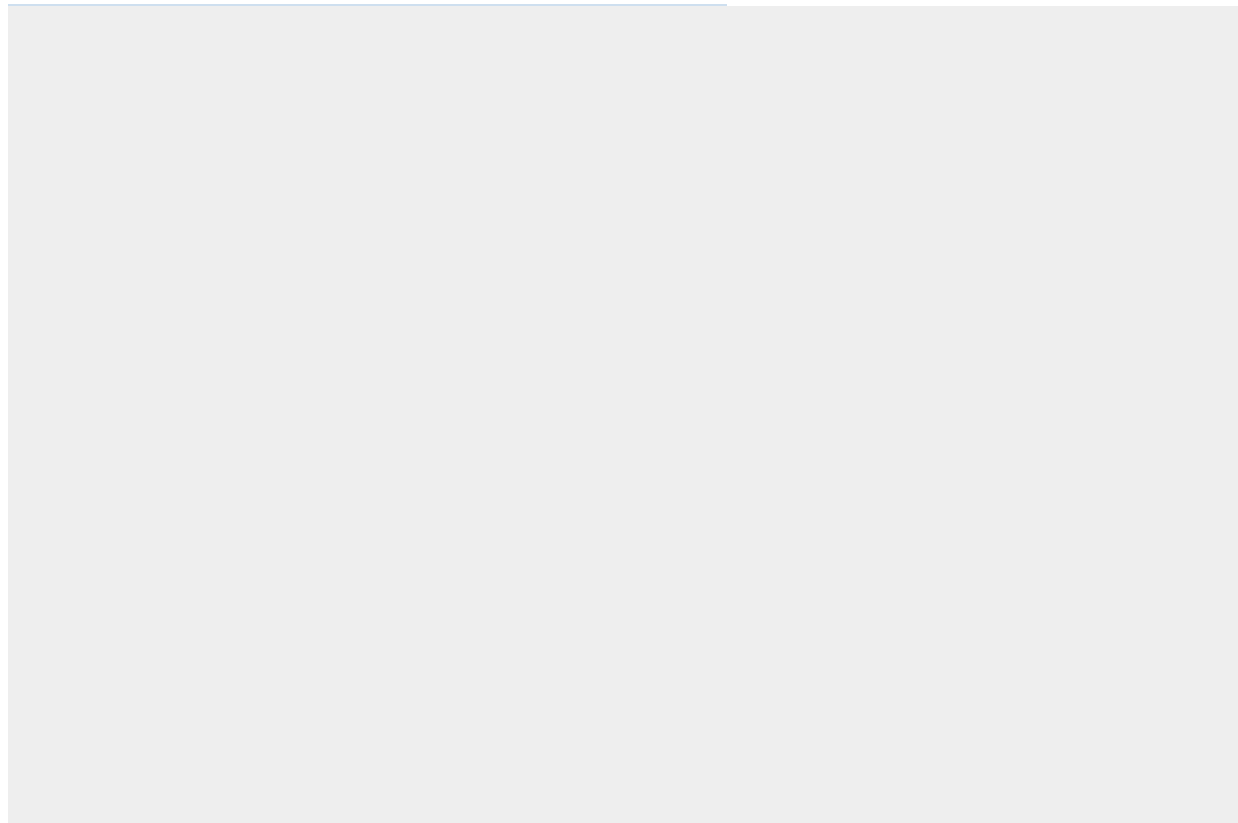


Joseph Pappas, man suspected of murdering George HW Bush's doctor, commits "suicide" after being confronted by police
