Sheryl Sandberg has changed her account of how much she knew about a PR firm that Facebook recruited to conduct smear campaigns against opponents. The chief operating officer of the social media giant said last week that she did not know it had hired Definers, a Republicanaffiliated consultancy, or "about the work they were doing".

She has now admitted that she was copied into a "small number of emails" that referenced the business and that some of its work was presented to her.
