FISA Court Cannot Exist If They Have "Secret" Operations "Against Political Enemies" Who Are U.S. Citizens Who Spoke Up

During an appearance on the Fox Business program this morning, Rep. Devin Nunes said that the FISA court cannot continue to exist if it is able to be weaponized by political parties against this opponents. This, of course, comes after the Democratic National Committee was able to plant the phony Steele Dossier with the FBI, and their media contacts, which eventually lead to the infamous Russia Investigation into Trump officials. Mr. Nunes spoke firmly about the DNC's weaponization of the FBI and FISA Courts: "We can't have a secret court operate like this in America where they're going to take and use it against political enemies.
